

GENERAL INFORMATION and SCHOOL POLICY

Location

This year we will be at Congregation Beth Israel in Northfield. Please arrive by 6:55 pm, at the Religious School entrance on the right side of the building, as classes start promptly at 7:00 pm. All doors will be locked at all times. If you arrive late, please use buzzer at the Religious School entrance.

School Closures

Kulanu will be closed for inclement weather if either Atlantic City HS or Mainland Regional HS are closed. An email blast will be sent to parents by 3:00 pm of the day in question, notifying you of the closure.

Attendance Policy

Kulanu attendance is a requirement at Congregations Beth Israel and Shirat Hayam for all B'nei Mitzvah students as well as for Confirmation. In addition, Kulanu attendance is also required in order to receive the Jewish Federation Israel Trip Stipend, Foundation Jewish Camp scholarships as well as eligibility for the Mendelsohn Scholarship.

Qualifying attendance will be above 75 percent for each trimester. We request that students miss no more than 3 classes per semester. At a point where you have an absentee record of more than 25 percent, Kulanu will notify you.

Safety

Students are not allowed to leave the school building at any time during the evening. If you need to pick up your child early, please come into the building to do so or send a note with your child.

Behavior

As guests at our host facility, we expect our students to be respectful of the property in these buildings. Out of respect for Kashrut Observance, no food is to be brought into the building. There will be ample time for snacks in between classes.

Graduation and Awards

The Graduation and Awards Program will be held on the last night of the school year. Students who have completed the program satisfactorily will graduate with special recognition given to those who have excelled in their commitment and effort. To be eligible for graduation we ask that all students maintain an attendance rate of at least 75%. In general, students attending for less time than the full requirement may receive recognition without graduation at the completion of 11th grade.
